Education _Generative AI + Pedagogy Meet-up

The COE, Vice Provost for Innovation in Education and the Provost are hosting a meet-up on generative AI and pedagogy. The COE recently made a significant investment in cutting-edge technologies and education, hiring three new faculty members (Drs. Juan Zheng, Zilong Pan and Shan Li, *joint with COH*) who are engaged in research in this area, particularly around the interface of new-wave technology and learning. We are planning an open campus conversation, entitled "Generative AI + Pedagogy Meet-up" featuring these faculty and the Provost Nathan Urban around the following questions:

- 1. How can we best use generative AI to enhance teaching and learning?
- 2. How might generative AI force changes in assessments? How can we best leverage those changes?
- 3. What research opportunities might generative AI create for education? Other fields?
- 4. What are some ethical considerations related to generative AI? How can we mitigate those?
- 5. If Lehigh were to 'plant a flag' on generative AI, what might we do? Which are the most promising lines of inquiry, practice, research to be first, best, only in this emerging field?

The meet-up will occur in Rauch 251 on February 27th from 2:00PM to 3:30PM. Dean Bill Gaudelli (COE) will moderate the conversation. Hope you will join us!
